

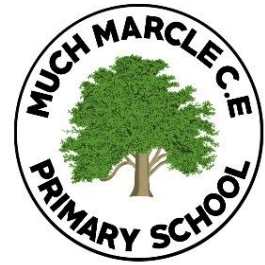

Class 4's Summer Newsletter

It is already the final term of the school year, and it is going to be a very busy term.

Although the Year 6 children will not be completing their SATs tests this year due to the cancellation of all national tests, we will be completing our own tests to support the teacher assessments that will be passed on to your child's High School.

Our topic this term is 'Marvellous Maps'. As part of this, we will be learning all about how we can use maps to help us to navigate our local area and beyond. Linked to this, we will be learning all about co-ordinates in Maths, as well as scaling and ratio and written calculation methods.

The children's PE lessons will consist of rounders and athletics and we will be visiting the woods for Forest School on Monday mornings. Please ensure your child comes to school in Forest School kit with uniform and shoes to change into when we return in time for lunch.

In Science, the children will be involved in lots of practical and theoretical work as we look at animals including humans.

In English we are starting off by studying some modern fiction - The Eighteenth Emergency by Betsy Byars - before we turn our focus to this year's school play. The children can hardly wait to find out what it is going to be; auditions and practice will be in full swing before we know it!

Children will receive a piece of Maths and English homework each week, along with their Frog Club and arithmetic sheets. Please continue to encourage your child to read and answer the comprehension questions in the back of their reading record as often as possible. Their reading record should be signed at least three times a week.

As ever, it is important that the children are prepared for the day. Full P.E kit is needed in order to take part and trainers must be in school every day for the mile run. At this time of year, it is also important that school jumpers are clearly named and water bottles, hats and sun-cream are in school every day when the weather warms up.
