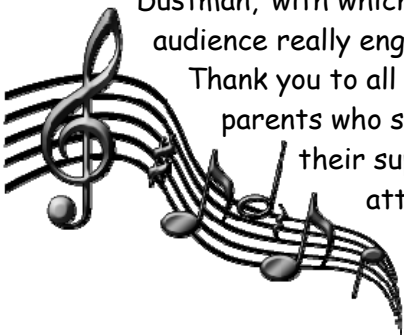


Pyramid Prom
