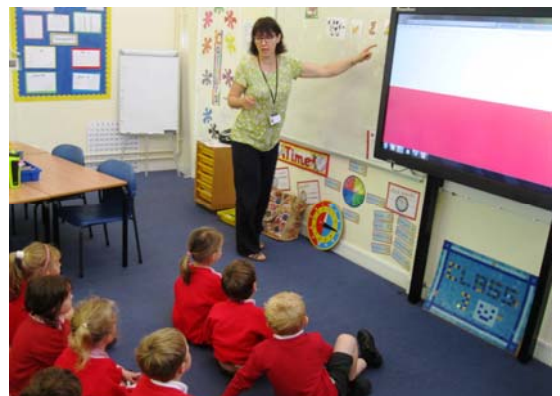
Celebration of Languages Day
