Whole School STEM Project for National Science Week Morgan Factory Visit

Our Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) project began with an exciting whole school trip to the Morgan Car Factory, on Wednesday 6th March. Children were taken on a tour of the factory, experiencing first hand how these beautiful cars are skilfully made by engineers.



During World Book Day, with the enthusiasm and knowledge gained from their trip, children were 'geared up' to design their own cars. Children became automotive designers for the day, as well as carrying out scientific experiments that could effect how they designed their cars.
