

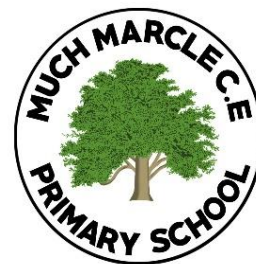

## Year 1 Summer Newsletter

Welcome back after what I hope was a relaxing Easter break.

### **Topic**

Our topic for this term is '**Food**'. This topic will run through all areas of the curriculum (see attached topic web). We have introduced our topic by reading Handa's surprise. We are going to learn about where in the world different foods come from and how food has changed over time.

### **Science**

In Science this term we will be identifying and naming some garden plants, growing our own beans and observing them in order to investigate what plants need to grow. We will also look at the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees. By the end of the unit, children will be confident in naming the different parts of a plant and their functions.

### **RE**

Over the summer term, we will be answering the questions: What makes some places sacred to believers? Why do Christians say God made the world?

### **PE**

Please ensure that your child has a PE kit in school and that each item is labelled with their name. Please check that names have not washed off school jumpers as well. We will be doing PE on a Tuesday and Forest School on the Bartons on a Monday afternoon. We hope that the weather stays fine but on any wet or dreary days please ensure your child has wellies and a coat.

Please continue to read a book three times with your child. Books will be changed on a Monday and Thursday and Spellings will be given on a Monday.
