If you or any families you know would benefit from any of the items on our schedule please do let us know as we can save some items before delivering them to Hereford.



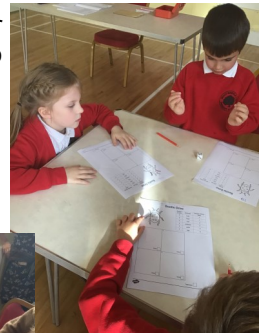
Governing Body
