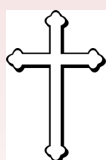

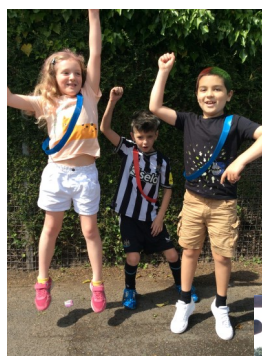


Year 6 SATs

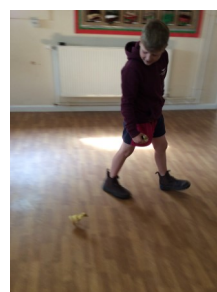
Break the Rules Day
