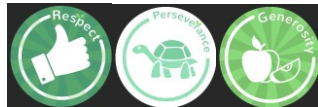

National Curriculum

As writers, we are learning to become creative writers and generate our own ideas and stories for pleasure thinking carefully about sentence structure.

As Readers, we are continuing to use our phonic knowledge to help us decode tricky words. We are also beginning to use chunking for longer words. We are able to answer questions on what we have just read.

As Mathematicians, we are applying our place value knowledge to help us work out answers quicker. We are applying our number fact knowledge to reasoning and problem solving questions. We are able to name 3D shapes and begin to talk about their properties.

As Scientists, we will explore everyday materials and their properties. We will think about the suitability of materials for certain things.

As Historians, we will look where we live. We will learn about the history of Hellens Manor.

As Geographers, we will locate the four countries of the UK on a map, Study Wales and aspects of physical geography.

As Musicians, we will Listen to, review and evaluate music across a range of historical periods.

As Artists, we will draw paint and sculpt different aspects of Hellens Manor and look at how architecture has changed over time.

As Computer Scientists, we will look at how we can make art using creative technology. We will also use a simple spreadsheet to look at gathering data.

As Sports People, we will look at invasion games and have a go at gymnastics.

As Theologians, in RE we will look at what is a Muslim and how do they live? As well as looking at why Easter is important to Christians. In PSHE we will learn about people around the world and thinking about how we keep ourselves safe.
